1- From the Dock, open "**System Preferences**".




2- Select "**Keyboard**".

## VENTURA, SONOMA, SEQUOIA OR HIGHER INSTRUCTIONS


3A- Open the drop-down menu for "Press Fn key to" and select "Do Nothing".



4A- Open the drop-down menu for "Touch Bar shows", and select "F1, F2, etc. Keys".

5A- Open the drop-down menu for "Press and Hold Fn key to" and select "Show Quick Actions".

6A- Turn off "Show typing suggestions".





### **MONTEREY INSTRUCTIONS**

3B- Open the drop-down menu for "**Touch Bar shows**", and select "**F1, F2, etc. Keys**".

4B- Open the drop-down menu for "**Press Fn key to**" and select "**Do Nothing**".


5B- Open the drop-down menu for "**Press and Hold Fn key to**" and select "**Show Quick Actions**".



## OLD VERSIONS' INSTRUCTIONS

3C- Open the drop-down menu for "**Touch Bar shows**", and select "**App Controls**".

4C- Open the drop-down menu for "**Press Fn key to**" and select "**F1, F2, etc. Keys**".



5- The Touch Bar will now display F1 to F12 keys and display nothing when you press Fn key. If you do not see a similar menu above, please contact ILG Customer Support.
